Description of research in which a candidate would attend and prospects for professional development

The main tasks of an employee at this position will be to conduct research in the biology of sprat to an extent necessary for the rational management of their resources. The work would include among others:

- Participation in the collection and supervision of the set of required biological and fisheries data,
- Participation in research cruises,
- Data analysis, including analyses using statistics procedures,
- Mathematical modelling of biological processes,
- Participation in the work of international expert groups.

The proposed position is an initial position - in the course of several years of work we will expect the scientific development of the employed person and, after meeting the appropriate requirements, transfer to a scientific position.

From a candidate we expect:

- Higher education (fish biology, fisheries, biophysics, biomathematics, etc.);
- Good knowledge of mathematics or mathematical statistics,
